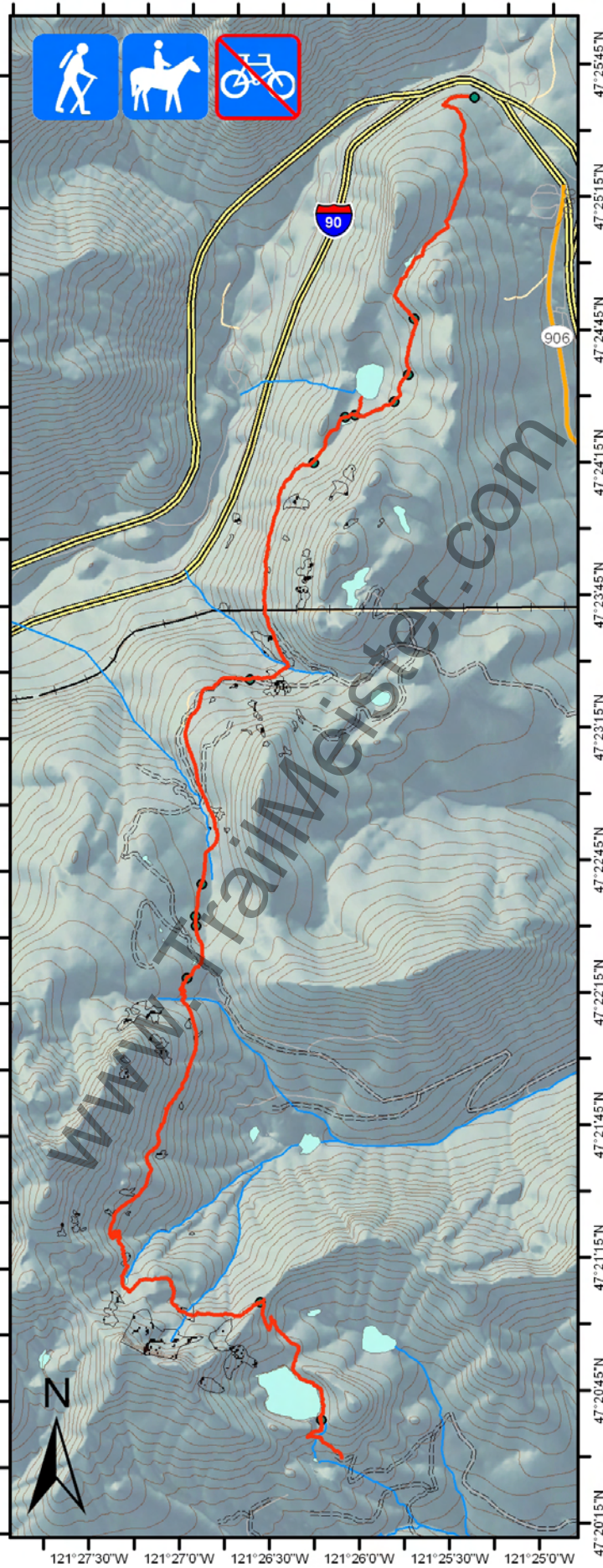


Mirror Lake - Pacific Crest Trail



Mirror Lake

Starting on the Pacific Crest Trail from Snoqualmie Pass and accessed from the Pacific Crest Trail, Mirror Lake is a nine mile trek past ski slopes, alpine lakes, shale slopes, and mountain meadows.

From the trailhead proceed through the forest for a short distance before entering the open ski slope area. Cross the saddle at the top of the slope and proceed down the opposite side past Lodge Lake.

Pass by Ollalie Meadow and proceed along the west and south sides of Silver Peak before rounding the bowl above Cold Creek on the north side of Tinkham Peak. Crest the ridge and then descend 300 feet to Mirror Lake. Return the same route you came.

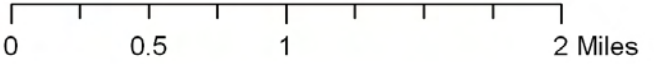
Getting here:
Exit 54 at the top of Snoqualmie Pass. Turn right
The Pacific Crest Trailhead is located at the upper parking lot.

Trail Tips

Let the slowest person in your hiking party set the pace. This is especially important when children are part of your group.

Plan the trip ahead of time and assign tasks that people enjoy. The goal is to have a good time outdoors.
