**TRAIL TERRAIN:** Flat, sand, soft ground, & barefoot friendly through Florida's beautiful longleaf pines

# FLORIDA LAW REQUIRES CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS, SHOW PROOF UPON ARRIVAL. ALSO FLORIDA LAW REQUIRES A HEALTH CERTIFICATE FOR ALL LIVESTOCK ENTERING THE STATE.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Brewton, AL, follow Hwy 41 South, 16 miles to Berrydale, FL (Hwy 41 becomes Hwy 87 at the Florida state line). Then turn East (left) onto Hwy 4, at the blinking caution light. Go 1 ¾ miles, then turn right on Gordon Land Road, following it 4 miles to camp on left.

From I-65 South, take Hwy 113 south to Flomaton, AL. Then take U.S. Hwy 29 South to Hwy 4 East, in Century, FL. Follow 4 East to the blinking stop light at Hwy 87. Go 1  $^{3}$ 4 miles farther to Gordon Land Rd; turn right and go 4 miles to camp on left.

From Crestview, FL, follow Hwy 90 West, 4 miles to Milligan; turn North (right) onto Hwy 4. Stay on Hwy 4 through the towns of Baker and Munson, a total of approximately 26 miles to Gordon Land Rd. Turn South (left) and follow Gordon Land Rd 4 miles to camp. If you reach a blinking light at the intersection of Hwy 4 and Hwy 87, you have missed the turn by  $1 \frac{3}{4}$  miles.

From Milton, FL, follow Hwy 87 North to Berrydale, FL. Turn East (right) onto Hwy 4, at the blinking caution light. Go 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> miles to Gordon Land Rd; turn right and go 4 miles to camp. **Qr** Off Hwy 87 take Hwy 191 (Munson Hwy) North 17 miles; turn Left on Buddy Hardy Rd, watch for Florida Forest Service signs to camp.
