

# Autumn Adventure at Big Hill

**Directions:** From **north:** From the intersection of US 169 and US 400, take 169 south to the Cherryvale Sonic Drive-in and turn left or east onto Main Street. From **south:** take US 169 north to the Cherryvale Sonic Drive-in.

**And then all:** Turn right or east onto Main Street. Continue east (about 2 mi) on Main Street all the way through Cherryvale to a T-intersection (bowling alley and gas station/convenience store).

Turn right for one block and then left, going east again on 5<sup>th</sup> St/5000 Road for about a mile.

Jog to the left and then to the right on paved road and continue east on 19000 Rd (about 3.6 mi) to park entrance at Cherryvale Parkway (before the dam). Turn left or north onto Cherryvale Parkway, go past 19065 Cherryvale Parkway (Corps of Engineers office) and follow ribbons north to horse camp.

**Camping:** No hook-ups, but water and pit toilets are available. **Dogs must be kept leashed or confined to your campsite and are not allowed at briefings or meals.** FREE camping due to volunteer work done there.

**Stabling:** Horses are to be stationary tied to trailers, hitching rails, or picket lines. Portable panel pens may not be used at this ride due to limited camping space.

**Check In, A Ride and Saturday B Ride:** Rider check-in with ride secretary begins at 1 p.m. Friday; Horses and riders check in with judges beginning at 2 p.m. Friday.

**Check In, Sunday B Ride:** Check-in starts at 4 p.m. on Saturday.

A current negative Coggins Certificate is required on all horses. A current Health Certificate (within 30 days of this event) is required on all out-of-state horses.

**Trails:** Trails are mostly wooded with some open meadows and some rocky creeks and hills. Shoes are recommended, but not required.

**Meals:** On your own.
