Join us for the 7IL Scamper Competitive Trail Ride (CTR) sponsored by the Sam Houston Trails Coalition (SHTC). All profits from this event will go to SHTC to help build the next phase of the Richards-Raven Equestrian Trail (16 miles of trails with multiple bridges and culverts). CTRs are distance events completed within a window of time with judging on horse and horsemanship (with obstacles). The sport is a great family activity as it is open to riders ages 10+ and all equine breeds.

TRAILS: Land is flat to gently rolling hills with wooded areas and clearings, creek crossings, and ravines. The trail surface is mostly natural grass and cow paths with some sandy areas particularly around creek beds. Ponds and creeks provide good drinking water on trail. The ranch is barefoot friendly!

FACILITIES: Facilities include public showers, restrooms, and a pavilion where ride briefings will be held. All rig sizes can be accommodated with lots of room for primitive camping. If you have a RV or living quarters trailer, the camp has 21 sites with water and 20/30/50 amp electric. Reservations are on a first serve basis, see IMPORTANT LINKS at the bottom of Page 2 to reserve a site.

STABLING: Horses in competition are not allowed to use 7IL horse pens because there are not enough pens available for all competition horses. All NATRC approved stabling options are allowed for horses in competition (tied to trailer, use of high ties, etc. please read NATRC rule book for details).

RIDE T-SHIRT: Enter by February 10 and you will be guaranteed a T-shirt. If registering online, please specify your T-shirt size in the Comments box. If paying by mail, specify size on your check.

MEALS & REGION 4 YEARLY AWARDS & BANQUET: <u>Volunteers will be fed all weekend.</u> Competitors are on their own for food. The NATRC Region 4 Yearly Awards Celebration will be held on Saturday evening after Ride Briefing and will offer dinner.
