

## Big River Adventure - July 23-24, 2022

**Trails:** Trails are maintained by Big River Ranch and are located in both the river bottom and surrounding hills with hardwood forest and meadows. The trails are dirt, well maintained with minimal rock.

**Directions:** From Kansas City MO take I70 east to Odessa, go North on MO 131 to MO 24, take MO 24 East to RT-224, go north on RT-224 to Goodloe Orchard Road From St. Joseph MO take US 36 east, go South on I35, go South on US 69, go East on MO 116, go South on MO 13, take Rt-224 South to Goodloe Orchard Road From Springfield MO take MO 13, take MO 24 East to RT-224, go north on RT-224 to Goodloe Orchard Road From Saint Louis MO take I70 West to MO 13, go North on MO 13 to MO 24, take MO 24 East to RT-224, go north on RT-224 to Goodloe Orchard Road

And ALL continue on Goodloe Orchard Road to Big River Ranch (*at the end of the road*).

**Camping:** There are 24 sites with 50 amp electric/water; restrooms and showers, conveniently located. Register for a camping site prior to July 1, through RMS system at [natrcr6.org](http://natrcr6.org) or contact Julie Landuyt at 816-695-4059. Electric/ water sites will be reserved on a first paid-first served basis. **July 1<sup>st</sup> and after, reserve camping sites by calling Big River Ranch at 660-232-0311.**

**Stabling:** Horses must be stationary tied. \*Leisure Division riders may use pens.

**Ride Notes:** A current negative Coggins Certificate is required on all horses. A current Health Certificate (within 30 days of this event) is required on all out-of-state horses. **Dogs** are not allowed in management area, check-in or briefing areas and **must be leashed** at all times (insurance requirement).

**Ride Details:** Late arrivals should make arrangements with ride management. Open, Novice and CP time-outs planned for 6:30 am on Saturday and Sunday.

**A Ride:** Check-in 2pm until dark on Friday - ride briefing planned for 6pm Friday and Saturday

**B1 Ride Saturday:** Check-in 2pm until dark on Friday - ride briefing planned for 6pm Friday

**B2 Ride Sunday:** Check-in 3-6pm on Saturday - ride briefing planned for 6pm Saturday

**B1 LeD Saturday:** Check-in 7:00 am on Saturday - ride briefing follows, time out at 8:30 am

**B2 LeD Sunday:** Check-in 7:00 am on Sunday - ride briefing follows, time out at 8:30 am

**Meals: Saturday Potluck in the event space - main dish provided by ride management**

**Entry Fees:** Minimum deposit \$30 **due by June 15**, refundable up to July 1
